August 13<sup>th</sup> 1897

A meeting of the Salford Parish Committee of the North Somerset Conservative Association was held at the Bungalow, Salford on Friday August 13<sup>th</sup> 1897 at 7.30 P.M.

Mr Nelson Heddow was Voted to the Chair, and there were present Messrs E. H. Tippet (Chief Agent and Secretary) Robert Clifton. E. Dixow. J. C. Lock. J. J. Ollis and others.

The Minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed

A letter was read from Mr Hood Daniel, who regretted, that having ceased to reside at Salford, he was obliged to resign the Chairmanship of the Committee.

On the proposition of Mr Heddow seconded by Mr Clifton and supported by Mr E. H. Tippet, it was unanimously resolved that a letter be written to Mr Hood.

Daniel, regretting he was obliged to resign the  
Chairman-ship, and thanking him for his  
services to the Conservative Party in Salford  
during his residence in the district.

Mr Dixon proposed that Mr Heddow  
be elected Chairman of the Salford Committee  
in succession to Mr Hood Daniel, and Mr  
Clifton seconded this proposition.  
Mr Heddow regretted he could not see his  
way to undertake the office.

On the proposition of Mr Dixon, seconded  
by Mr Ellis, Mr Robert Clifton was  
unanimously elected Chairman of the  
Salford Committee.

On the proposition of Mr Lock, seconded  
by Mr Clifton, Mr Heddow was unanimously  
elected Vice Chairman

Mr Clifton kindly consented to  
undertake the duties of Hon Sec<sup>r</sup> to the  
Local Committee together with the  
Chairman-ship
